NEW WORKS BY LEE CASEY AT ANELLE GANDELMAN FINE ART

LARCHMONT – New paintings by Maryland artist Lee Casey will be on view at Anelle Gandelman Fine Art from April 5 through May 5. Lee Casey's style is bold, gestural, and abstract. She works on several paintings at the same time creating continuity in her energetic and spontaneous works. The subject for many of the paintings on exhibit is landscape, sometimes evident and sometimes not.

Lee Casey comes from a strong artistic background emphasizing drawing as the foundation for painting. The use of line and mark-making is always present in her work. She also incorporates texture and collage into her current pieces. Casey says, "I scratch, rub and push the paint - I add papers, photos, oil pastel and charcoal to create an exciting tactile surface."

In "The Georgetown", critic Sophia McCrocklin writes, "Her works are strong, bold and colorful with a skillful use of line... The abstraction resonates deeply. Casey's bold energetic work awakens the senses."

Lee Casey was born in New Jersey. She earned her M.F.A. from The American University in Washington, DC and a bachelor's degree from The Pennsylvania State University. Her work is represented in numerous public and private collections, including Wheat Securities in Virginia, Perpetual Bank in Washington DC, and Media Marketing Associates in White Plains, NY. Lee Casey presently lives and works in Rockville, MD.

There will be a reception for the artist on April 5 from 6PM to 8PM.
